## **Breakfast Club**

Breakfast Club will be available from 8.15am to 8.45am, in the main hall from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> November. After 8.45am, children will move to their classrooms where a member of staff will greet them. Children need to be in Breakfast Club by 8.30am to give time for them to eat their food. The cost will be £1 per day and the days booked on a Friday for the following week. Any child in school before 8.45am must be in Breakfast Club for supervisory purposes.

This will be run as a 3-month trial and then we will evaluate if there is an ongoing need for this service to be in place. If your child is attending Breakfast Club, please park as usual and the children are to walk on the footpath at the side of the building in the carpark and enter the school using the front door. Please do not park in the carpark or allow children to walk through the middle of the carpark as this is a busy time for staff arriving.

Healthy break will still be served by Mrs Kelly Monday to Thursday.

Please be aware we do have children in Clare Primary School who have severe nut allergies.
